Assisting in school carnivale duties, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • general food handling if required • collecting money if required • setting up and serving on stalls if required • working as part of a team • preparing food if required • serving at the stalls if required • selling food and drink items if required • wiping down counters/tables etc • washing and putting away equipment • general cleaning duties • restocking stalls as needed. • praising appropriate behaviour and encouraging modification of inappropriate behaviour • modelling acceptable behaviour and language. 2. Other duties as directed.
